WHO IS SPONSORING THE SCHOLARSHIP FUND?

The Los Angeles Sheriff's Star Organization is sponsoring this scholarship fund to assist the children or legal dependents, as well as the current employees of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department. LASSO is a non-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization with a broad member base composed of civic and corporate leaders committed to honoring the members of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department.



WHAT ARE THE DEADLINES AND RELEVANT DATES?

June 15, 2010: Scholarship applications must be post marked no later than this date.

July 16, 2010: Notifications mailed to scholarship recipients.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP?

Current employees of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department as well as their children or legal dependents who are not previous LASSO scholarship recipients and are currently enrolled in or plan to attend college or trade/tech school, or will have graduated from high school by June 2010. These funds may be used to cover costs and expenses for a variety of higher educational institutions.

WHO WILL MAKE THE SCHOLARSHIP DECISION?

A scholarship committee administered by the Los Angeles Sheriff's Star Organization will select the scholarship recipients.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

You must have the most current scholarship application form. A typed application is viewed more favorably by the judges, so we strongly advise you to type rather than handwrite your application. Two letters of recommendation and your most recent transcripts are necessary to complete the application.



The submitted application should contain the following: (in this order)

1. Application Form
2. Personal Statement
3. Two letters of recommendation (one should be from an official or supervisor at your school, and the other should be from someone other than a relative)
4. Most recent transcript

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT'S RATING WORKSHEET

This worksheet arrives at a rating for each applicant, measuring several aspects of the candidate's life. The maximum rating is 100 points. This process is intended to minimize subjective metrics, while still recognizing qualities that are not easily quantified. Therefore, the following parameters are discussed.

NEED

This factor is rated by considering several factors, including:

- Family Income
- Number of dependents in the family
- Number of children in school
- Total cost for the applicant to attend school
- Hardships or other circumstances

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Consideration will be given to the applicant's extracurricular activities including work, the applicant's commitment level to each activity, and the nature of the activity. Particular emphasis will be placed on activities related to public service and community service. Also, the presentation of the applicant's Personal Statement will be considered.

HOW MANY SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE?

There will be a minimum of 10 scholarships of \$5,000 each, which includes funding proudly donated to LASSO by The Gene Autry Foundation, Erika Glazer, Kenneth Corday, David Saperstein and Simon T.
